Lodge Application & Agreement

The mission of the Indiana Masonic Home's Pillars Program is to allow organizations within our Masonic family to be connected with a current IMH resident for the purpose of fellowship and friendship. We thank you for your interest in this program.

Guidelines for Participation

As a Pillars Lodge or Chapter, we ask that you will:

- Assign one member to contact the sponsored resident on a routine basis.
- Sending your Pillar resident personalized written correspondence: letter and cards are best!
- Sending care packages of inexpensive items.
- · Remember your Pillar resident's birthday and holidays with cards or inexpensive gifts
- Visiting the sponsored resident at the Indiana Masonic Home, taking them to lunch or dinner or if possible, to one of your meetings, if possible.
- Mailing your Pillar resident your newsletters or other similar communications.
- Contact the lodge or chapter the resident is a member of, and letting them know of your involvement.
- Attend the funeral of you Pillar resident when they pass, and participate in an memorial ceremonies.
- Bring any issues or concerns regarding your Pillar resident directly to the immediate attention of the Chaplain. The best way to do this is through a phone call to the Indiana Masonic Home.
- Work within the guidelines of HIPPA laws, and recognize that we must also.
- Relate closely and fraternally to the families of residents, especially those of dementia patients.

As a Pillars Lodge or Chapter, we ask that you do not:

- Give your Pillars residents money or expensive gifts.
- Ask your Pillars resident what they want or need. Your friendship is the best gift you can give!
- Get involved in conflicts your resident may be having with other residents or IMH staff.
- Make requests for specific residents, residents from specific counties or areas, specific genders, or other preferences.
